Text: Mark 8:1-12

- 1. Share a story of a season when you longed to belong. How did it turn out?
- 2. Compare and contrast the feeding of the 4000 with the feeding of the 5000. What significance is there in the differences? In the similarities?
- 3. Are you convinced by David's conclusion that Mark 7 Mark 8:1-12 is an expansion of Jesus' mission for the benefit of Gentiles as well as Jews?
- 4. "Jesus is for anyone" how is this a true statement? How might it be mistaken? How do you have a hard time believing this for yourself? What "others" do you have difficulty believing this about?
- 5. How does your difficulty believing "Jesus is for anyone" about others affect your thoughts, attitudes, actions, and behaviors toward "those people"?
- 6. How does that cause you to miss out on the work Jesus is doing and wants to do?
- 7. Are you a complainer? Why do you complain? What's underneath all of that?
- 8. What keeps you from joining in the work Jesus is doing and wants to do?
- 9. How does Jesus' example in the feeding of 5000 with a clear "division of labor" free you to join in his work?
- 10. Who is Jesus telling you "I have compassion for these people" and how will you set what Jesus gives you before them?
